Briefing, listing, walk and Quest competition after orientation/instruction on how to observe birds and issue of bird list and quest challenge (prize for winner). Some of the unique species you may come across include the Superb Fairy-wren (*Malurus cyaneus*), the New Holland Honeyeater (*Phylidonyris novaehollandiae*) or the Willie Wagtail (*Rhipidura leucophrys*). Bring your own binoculars.

**Meeting Point** - Entrance to the bushland to the south of the carpark at the Visitor Centre end of the car park. Walk rating – easy.
